Bike Project

PCSO Christopher Fleming has brought the bike project back to the Anson Cabin. After a 2 year funding drought, Chris working in partnership with management at the Anson Cabin, has managed to secure £800 to get the workshop back up and running again.

This time around the bike project will be working in partnership with Bike Right in order to ensure that local young people in the area understand

how to ride their bikes safely on busy urban roads.

Young people are invited to bring their bikes along to workshops sessions, there they will learn how to keep their bikes in tip top condition, changing tires and replacing brakes etc. Once their bikes have been fully serviced and are safe for riding on Manchester's busy roads they attend a two day cycling proficiency course provided by Bike Right. This has

been a successful project over the summer holidays so more sessions are planned for autumn half term. If your child is 9 years of ages or older and is interested in attending the bike workshop and proficiency course, contact the Anson Cabin office.

Chris is also fixing bikes up for victims of crime who have had their bikes stolen.



Youth Sessions 2014-2015

During the Youth Sessions we do a variety of activities, including pool, Table Tennis, PS4, Arts and Crafts and also cooking sessions. As well as the fun stuff we also offer informal Education sessions to develop new skills, enjoy being part of a community and also to increase their confidence.

We have undertaken a variety of workshops such as careers advice and job searches, drug and alcohol sessions, sexual health, and also healthy eating. We are regularly having cooking sessions here at Anson Cabin, allowing young people to dictate the foods that they prepare, and trying to explore a variety of different cultures. During the sessions we have topical discussions that are in the news and also informal discussions around relationships and education.

Here at Anson we have young people who have been involved within the Central youth Panel who have fed back on a variety of issues and also engaged in projects that are affecting young people within the locality.

On a Wednesday Night young people have been involved in Fitness sessions, mainly around Football, but

also some boxercise/boxing sessions run by cabin staff. These have allowed Young People to remain Fit and Healthy and also allowed young people to explore the benefits of regular exercise. The Football sessions are facilitated by John Williams Coaching company, in Partnership with MYA, which has allowed the project to broaden its reach. Young People will in the future be offered a variety of volunteering opportunities such as the painting of MYA, which will work towards an accreditation.

Here at Anson Cabin we offer the Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Award. We are proud of the fact that we are the only Youth Funded Project to be an Accredited Centre, completely self sufficient, allowing young people to work towards the award. Young People are now able to cook using camping equipment such as a Trangia, can erect tents, and are also working towards route planning for the expedition module of the award. Anson Cabin now also has 3 members of staff that are able to deliver this award, which will again increase the reach of the project, and allow even more young people to undertake this award.

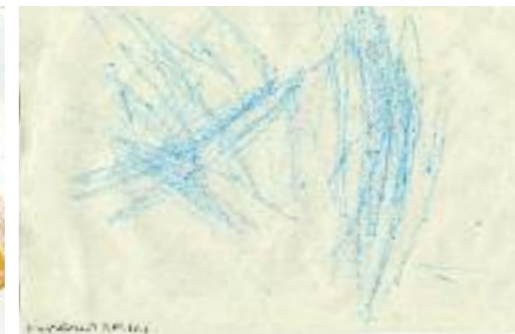
