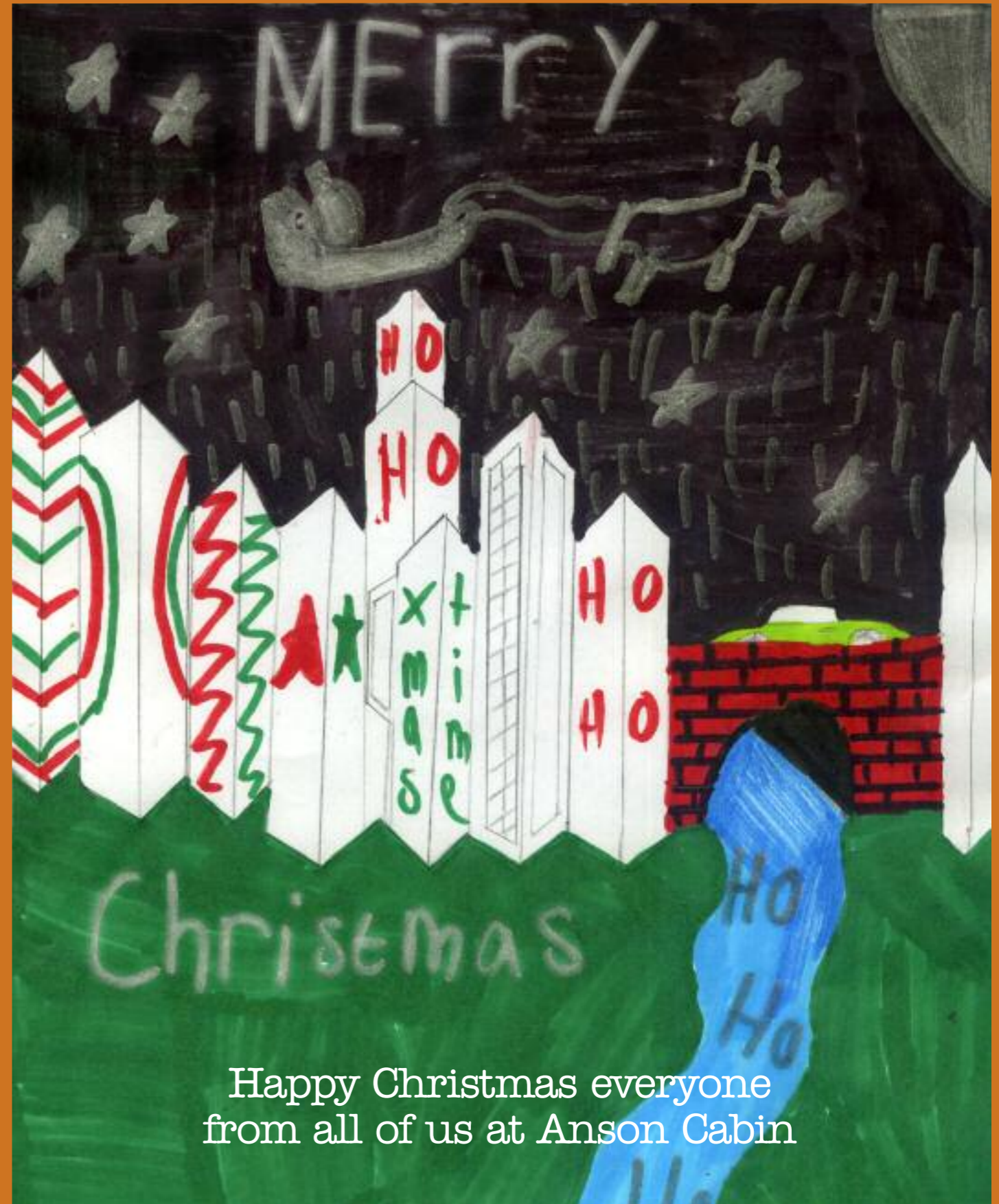

Anson Cabin projects in 2016

Anson Cabin Youth project (12-17 year olds)

The project ran workshops throughout the year with young people attending workshops, learning new skills, building confidence and self-esteem as well as team-work skills.

We have a young volunteers programme aimed at children and young people aged 14 - 19 years old. Everyone gets the opportunity to volunteer, after police checks, gaining valuable experience in a work place as well as learning new skills and knowledge.

Activities have included first aid training, residentials to Ghyll head, sports, arts and crafts including music workshops and Graffiti art workshops, young people have also been learning skills in camp craft, map reading, volunteering as part of Duke of Edinburgh Award which is delivered at the cabin free of charge on Monday and Thursday evenings. Our senior youth worker Kal also supports sessions at Manchester Youth Academy on a Wednesday evening 6.30-8.30pm.

Anson Cabin Play Project (5-13 year olds)

What a busy and fun year we have had, both on and off site the children have done so much!

Our trips have been too

- Local swimming pools
- visits to the local parks and museums
- Beach trips – Blackpool and St Anne's,
- Outdoor adventures at Lyme park and Crocky trail,
- Ghyll head 2 night residential, where children and young people took part in activities such as kayaking, canoeing, abseiling, rock climbing, caving and scrambling.
- Coming up in December our annual panto trip.

Children have also taken part in first aid training and the Adventure Service Challenge scheme.

Onsite activities have included – arts and crafts, planting and growing strawberries, self-esteem games, fun days,

Anson Cabin Play group (2-5 year olds)

We are registered to take up to 12 children aged 2-5 years old. This allows us to support the small group and give one to one support. We help the children to develop with activities such as bug hunting, indoor and outdoor creative play, and messy play. We encourage counting, spelling and social interaction - as well as building confidence and self esteem.
